## Aboard the Big Nude Cruise

For its 29th year anniversary, Bare Necessities offered The Big Nude Boat cruise around the Caribbean Sea, making four ports of call. This was my first ocean cruise ever — let alone a clothing-optional one — and I anticipated this trip for months. My friends Kevin and Martha from Georgia met me at Port Canaveral where 2800-plus strangers embarked aboard the Carnival Sunshine for a nine-day venture from January 25 – February 3.

The first stop was Half Moon Cay where I encountered hundreds of “full moons” across the sugary white clothes-free sands of this private Bahamian island. After lunch, I explored the souvenir stands and warmed to the tropical breezes before getting dressed (yuck) for the return tender to the ship. Next was Ocho Ríos for a bus tour that introduced me to Jamaican life, the Fern Gully, jerk chicken at Bamboo Beach Club and many opportunities to sample the local rums. The ship then docked in Mahogany Bay on the Honduran island of Roatán.

## GE Says It “Dodged Yet Another Bullet” From Most Recent Rainstorms

January 18, 2019 – On its 11pm newscast, local television station KABC-TV said Glen Eden nudist park TV suffered another flood of mud from 4 days of heavy rain (with some screen images of water flowing through the parking lot).

GE’s General Manager Art Bell told us this was “Fake news, LOL” as the creek running through the park did open up “and took a new path,” but there was no damage. “We are repairing it now... We dodged a bullet.” Residents were evacuated for several days as the storm approached but all activities returned to normal within two days.

Two weeks later another series of storms forced yet another mandatory evacuation. No damage was reported, and the planned Superbowl Party went on as usual.

February 14 - As we went to press, the seventh storm to hit the area in recent weeks caused yet another evacuation. VP Steve Spencer wrote following on Instagram:

2/14/19 at 3:45 pm... As predicted, Glen Eden has experienced a rain event that has again caused flooding. Everyone is safe and the preparations made have certainly saved the club from major damage! We will again be digging out and cleaning for a few days. Eden West sites have been impacted. The creek also breached again on the tennis courts 5&6 side. While this presents another challenge for our club, our facilities survived with minor damage. We should be good to go for the weekend!

## Scavaging Nudes at The Getty Museum Brings Out the Fun

An art museum is always a great place to admire great works of art containing various poses of the human nude. Each January several clubs in Southern California collectively meet at the Getty Museum in West Los Angeles for an annual “Nude Scavenger Hunt.” No, the club members cannot be nude themselves, but the hunt asks participants to find the answers to over 100 questions about various nude paintings, statues, and other objects throughout the 4-building complex.

Example: “In Room E103, who is the dying lover of Venus in this sculpture?” (Answer: “Adonis.”)

This year, the Getty hosted a special exhibit “The Renaissance Nude” which gave our members plenty of additional opportunities for the contest.

The Renaissance Nude exhibit was upstairs in the Exhibitions Pavilion, and many of us thought it was a real shame we could not be nude ourselves while searching for answers to the questions about the nude artwork displayed in the various galleries and rooms.

If you have never visited the Getty, it sits up on a hill in the Sepulveda pass above the 405 Freeway and on a clear day, it provides a spectacular panorama view of downtown Los Angeles.

The grounds contain four two-story pavilions filled with classic paintings and sculptures collected from around the world. It also has a world-class research center, museum studio, and sculpture garden.

Six teams of 2-3 people competed including three from SCNA, two from the Olympians club and one from Orange County’s NitOC club. The winning team came in at 2 hrs. and 2 minutes and missing only 4 out of 119 questions.

Afterwards, some people decided to go back into the museum to see certain exhibits more closely or to take of the guided walking tours. Others went for a late lunch-early dinner in the Getty cafeteria to watch the sun set over the Pacific Ocean.

## Other Nudist News



### Story of 1999 Serial Killer Captured at Laguna del Sol retold on ABC-TV 20/20

On July 25, 1999, astute members and guests of the Laguna del Sol nudist resort near Sacramento, California, recognized serial killer Cary Stayner at the resort, notified authorities and successfully detained him until the FBI could arrive and arrest him. This dramatic story was only a small part of a two-hour 20/20 show broadcast on January 25 on ABC TV.

Stayner had murdered three women in Yosemite National Park the previous winter, but he did not become a person of interest to law enforcement until another woman was brutally murdered six months later.

Stayner left the murder scene and drove to LDS to hide but the local residents became suspicious as he did not “blend in” as he had hoped. After learning he was being sought for questioning, one woman made the call to the FBI while other LDS members arranged for a motor home to conveniently stall, blocking the exit gate until the authorities could arrive. Only the woman’s call was mentioned during the broadcast, as the show credited the FBI agent who showed up and took him into custody as being the hero who cracked the case.

LDS was given about 3 minutes total out of the two-hour show because the producers apparently wanted to focus on Stayner’s motivation, which they theorized was caused by his younger brother having been kidnapped and sexually abused for seven years a decade earlier.

### Nudity Required for French Audiences Who Attend Nudist Play

The Los Angeles Fringe Festival wasn’t the first venue to host a play where both the actors and the audience were nude, and apparently it won’t be the last as the French have adopted the concept for themselves.

On January 20, a new play named *Nu et Approuve* (translation: “Nude and Approved”) opened in Paris at the Palais des Glaces theater. The audience is required to strip off their clothes and sit on a towel to watch it. According to the theater website, VIPs will be provided with their own microfiber seat covering, but everyone will have to bring their own towel.

The web site describes the play as a story of a brother and sister who find themselves on opposite sides of prickly social issues. In order to find common ground, they must shed off all masks and inhibitions and get naked. The term “Nu et approuve” is said to be a commonly used formula in France for a signing of official documents. The one act play lasts 1 hour 15 minutes.

This piece of drama has been supported by the French Federation of Naturism and the Association of Naturists of Paris. There are now several naked comedy shows throughout the city, advertised nude museum visits, restaurants and other tourist spots as the city seems to be discovering the tourist potential of nudists from other countries. Paris also has a nudist zone in its biggest park.

We could not find any reviews of the play in subsequent newspapers printed after the play’s opening.
